RE: **OPWC Issue 1 Infrastructure Projects** Round 36 (Fiscal Year 2023)

It's now time to start thinking about infrastructure projects you want to submit for Round 36 to be constructed in 2023.

Completed project application forms must be submitted to the Regional Planning Commission Office by **noon on October 1, 2021**. The County Meeting to review submitted projects will be held on **THURSDAY October 14, 2021 at 2:00 PM** in PROSPECT ROOM, lower level of the County Administrative Building.

The following should be completed **online** to apply. Go to www.pwc.ohio.gov

1. The first six pages of the OPC Application for Financial Assistance, including project cost estimate by a registered civil engineer. (www.pwc.ohio.gov. click on "PROGRAMS", then on drop-down menu "Infrastructure Programs", then slide to the right to "Infrastructure Application") **FOR OUR OCTOBER 1ST DEADLINE YOU MAY USE LAST YEAR'S FORM, BUT, new this year, EACH COMMUNITY WILL BE REQUIRED, SOMETIME BEFORE NOVEMBER 5th, TO USE A NEW STATE "WORKWISE" PORTAL FOR THE APPLICATION so you might want to try to use this now.**
2. District 16 Project Evaluation Form (www.pwc.ohio.gov click on "DISTRICT", then on drop-down menu "District 16" then go to "Infrastructure Program", then "Methodology") NOTE: that if you also want to review the District 16 Calendar or New Fiscal Year 2022(RND- 35) Manual skip the last step above, and after going to Infrastructure Program, click on either "District Calendar" or "Application Manual"
