The Ohio Public Works Commission's (OPWC) District 17 Integrating Committee is seeking nominations for two (2) members for **District 17 Natural Resources Assistance Council (NRAC)** to serve through the timeframes noted below. The District 17 geographical jurisdiction includes Delaware, Fairfield, Knox, Licking, Morrow and Pickaway Counties. The open appointments must be from the following categories:

- **One (1) member representing Group 4:** A statewide organization representing agriculture, an organization representing forestry interests, the Department of Agriculture, or the U.S. Department of Agriculture.
Term: November 2021 through November 2024

- **One (1) member** representing one of the 5 categories as defined by Ohio Revised Code 164.21 (A)(1):
 - **Group 1:** County, municipal corporation, township, conservancy district, regional or joint district or unit of government, or regional or joint political subdivision.
 - **Group 2:** Conservation or environmental advocacy organization, an organization with a primary interest in watershed protection and restoration, the Department of Natural Resources, the Environmental Protection Agency, or the U.S. Natural Resources Conservation Service.
 - **Group 3:** A city park system or metropolitan park system or a board of park commissioners located within the geographical jurisdiction of the appointing integrating committee, a statewide parks and recreation organization, or the U.S. National Park Service.
 - **Group 4:** A statewide organization representing agriculture, an organization representing forestry interests, the Department of Agriculture, or the U.S. Department of Agriculture.
 - **Group 5:** An organization representing business, local realtors, or a planning agency, including a port authority, located within the geographical jurisdiction of the appointing integrating committee.

Term: November 2021 through November 2024

Nominees must represent a recognized organization or entity as defined in Section 164.21 (A) of the Ohio Revised Code. NRAC members are appointed by District 17's Integrating Committee. The District 17 NRAC is a working committee that is responsible for allocating the funds made available to the District 17 NRAC through the Clean Ohio Conservation Fund. Members of District NRACs **may not** be compensated for personal or
